

Saffires Outreach Security Role Description

The purpose of Saffires outreach is to visit premises in the city where sex is sold and offer a pastoral/chaplaincy service to those affected by the off-street sex industry with a predominant focus on women selling sex. The team will seek to build genuine relationships with women, and where appropriate offer prayer, sharing the good news of Jesus as well as meeting immediate needs and referring to appropriate services and agencies.

Person Specification

Any individual wishing to join the outreach team should display the following qualities and attributes:

- Be able to show their faith is central to their life and work ethic
- Be accountable to a local church and actively serving and involved there
- Be reliable
- Be able to make sensible decisions in complex and challenging situations
- Be aware of the risks to volunteers and coordinators on outreach
- Able to communicate clearly
- Not easily phased or overly emotional
- Over the age of 21

Security Role

The security team member will:

- Complete relevant training before commencing outreach
- Agree to the Saffires statement of faith, code of conduct and safeguarding and confidentiality policies
- Keep all premises information strictly confidential
- Be in one location for the duration of the outreach visit, with their phone nearby at all times with continuous signal
- Aware of the security procedures for phone contact with the outreach team
- Be prepared to call the police immediately if they are unable to make contact with the team after the agreed time, or if they receive a phone call from the outreach team where they hear the safe word or the team sound to be in distress.
- Pray for the outreach team while they are visiting
